The interview on leadership talk with Mr Gautam Bambawale on 23-04-2020 is considered to be one of the significant interviews in the recent days for the reason that it brings out the new opportunities for India after the post Covid-19 global scenario in the areas like Politics, Economics and Soft issues like Education, Tourism, etc. Mr Gautam Bambawale has presented his views on the initiatives taken by Indian government to grab these opportunities in the aforesaid sectors.

Dr. Abhay Jere has begun the interview with an introduction of the invitee Mr Gautam Bambawale. He was the former Indian Ambassador to Bhutan, Pakistan and China and a distinguished professor at Symbiosis International University, Pune. Moreover, he is a senior Adviser to OLA. Therefore, it was a gilded opportunity for the audience to have the inspiring personality for the interview.

On answering the question of India's possible benefits after the post Covid-19 pandemic, Mr Bambawale has mentioned the image of China has been severely hit and its credibility has been suffered a great blow for mishandling the sensitive Covid-19 pandemic.

He observed this had created an opportunity for India to take global leadership in the political scenario. Similarly, in the economic domain he has said that many leading global firms from the countries like Japan, Korea, Germany, UK and USA are thinking to move their business out of China. Their target preferences are happening to be the countries like Vietnam, Malaysia, and India. He added India should take quick measures to bring these companies to our country to envision our Make in India concept and create employment opportunities for India's youth sector. He has also mentioned that the post pandemic scenario would attract more students to our premier educational institutions besides reducing our students educational visit to China.

Dr. Abhay Jere has raised concerns over the rigid formalities followed by the Indian government against the start up of new business in India. Responding to this, Mr Bambawale opined that such formalities needed to be addressed and it will surely cause hardship for the business entrepreneurs both in India as well as foreign countries. He has equally said that doing business in India will benefice the investors in two ways. At first, the labor cost is remarkably low in India compared to the other foreign countries. Furthermore, India itself remains a massive market for the investors.

On responding to a question on the subsidies got by India from the US and the pressure applied by the China after the export of Hydroxychloroquine, Mr.Bambawale answered beautifully by mentioning the philosophies of the two nations. India follows the philosophy called Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam which means the world remains a single family. The Chinese philosophy Chung-kuo believes a concept that everything should revolve around China. He opined the Indian philosophy would empower India to gain global leadership after the post Covid-19 pandemic.

Dr. Abhay Jere question on the tension prevails between India and China on economic investments, Mr.Bambawale answered that the Indo-China relationship is complex and he opined it would not affect the Chinese the investment in long term.

The interview was much useful to the audience, and it brought out many untold facts of India's political and economic relationship with the rest of the world. The good news about the interview is the employment opportunities for the youth community. The post Covid-19 pandemic scenario has fostered a good image for India globally and it will encourage the country to perform a lead role in the political arena in future. Furthermore, it is going to promote the foreign investment in India to help the student community to get abundant employment opportunities in the near future. The staffs and students of Karaikal Polytechnic College were extremely delighted to hear the interview of our former diplomat Mr Gautam Bambawale.
