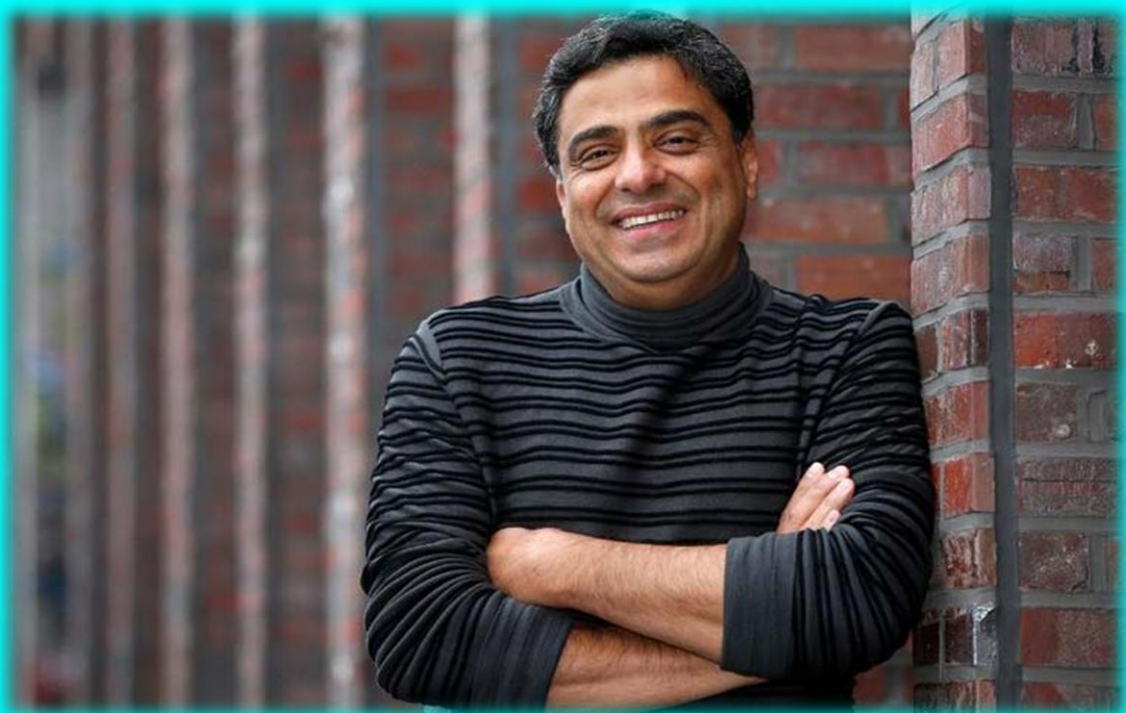

The advice given to become a successful entrepreneur is wanted to do something on our own and the reason for multiple failures is due to lack of experience. From his story we came to know that success comes only after so many failures. Preplanning, recalibrating and learning from failures could lead to a successful entrepreneur.

We observed that to excel in various sectors the expert said that he had strong belief in serendipity and need creativity in business opportunity. It is insisted that building brands, getting credibility, listening process, research etc. are the key notes to excel in various sectors.

To survive in the Post COVID world the idea of what kind of startups, in terms of technology-huge business is given by the speaker. We got inspired by the idea that Incredible things can be done in Non-glamorous sectors such as health care, agriculture, Water conservation, waste management, education etc.

The Future of education in India was also discussed. The significance of online teaching and technology to play are discussed. It is insisted that Teachers have to realize that the only way to do teaching during this pandemic period is online teaching.

India can emerge in Post COVID world with the 4<sup>th</sup> industrial revolution wherein it is no more of a processing house but as a big source of entrepreneurs who can give high quality, right price and mass production in business.

Overall the session gave us a positive attitude to survive in the post-COVID environment.
